### **Incidents:**

- **Home Invasion / Shooting** - On March 26<sup>th</sup> at 2:40AM, police responded to the 14200 block of Mount Pleasant Dr in Woodbridge (22191) for a shooting. The victim, a 37 year old man of Woodbridge, reported to police that he was asleep in the basement of the residence when he heard a loud bang. Two unknown men had kicked in his bedroom door where one of the men pointed a handgun at the victim and fired. The men then fled the house in an unknown direction. The victim sustained a gunshot wound to the chest and was flown to an area hospital with non-life threatening injuries. No other injuries were reported. This incident was not a random act. Investigation continues.
- **Assault by Mob / Stabbing** - On March 25<sup>th</sup> at 9:06PM, police responded to Potomac Mills Mall located at 2700 Potomac Mills Cir in Woodbridge (22192) for a fight in the parking lot. The victim, a 17 year old male of Dale City, reported to police that he was walking through the parking lot when he was approached by several individuals who began assaulting him. During the altercation, one of the individuals cut the victim with an unknown object to his abdomen. All individuals fled the area on foot. The victim was treated at an area hospital for non-life threatening injuries. Investigation continues.
- **Stabbing** - On March 25<sup>th</sup> at 2:41PM, police responded to investigate an alleged stabbing which occurred in the area of Main St just north of Quantico Gateway Dr in Dumfries (22026). The victim, a 26 year old man of Dumfries, reported to police that he was in the area above when he was stabbed in the upper body by a known male acquaintance. The man then left the area. The victim was transported to an area hospital with non-life threatening injuries. Investigation continues.
