**Incidents:**

- **Crash – Fatal** - On April 20<sup>th</sup> at 12:02AM, police responded to the area of Logmill Rd just west of James Madison Hwy in Haymarket (20169) for a single vehicle crash. A preliminary investigation revealed that the driver of a 2005 Dodge Magnum was traveling westbound on Logmill Rd when it struck a deer that crossed its path. That collision caused the driver to lose control and strike a tree. Five occupants were inside the vehicle at the time of the collision. Of the five occupants, one was pronounced dead at the scene. The other four occupants were all flown to an area hospital for critical injuries. Speed was a factor in this crash. None of the occupants were wearing a seat belt at the time of the collision. On Friday, April 22<sup>nd</sup>, a second occupant involved in last week's crash on Logmill Rd has succumbed to their injuries.

- **Burglary / Malicious Wounding** - On April 24<sup>th</sup> at 10:05PM, police responded to the 2000 block of Horizon Ct in Woodbridge (22191) for an armed robbery. The victim, a 64 year old woman of Woodbridge, reported to police that she was sitting in her living room with the sliding glass door opened, when she heard the screen slide open and an unknown man enter. The man displayed a handgun and demanded money. A struggle ensued and the man stuck the victim on the head with the handgun. The man grabbed the victim's purse, which was sitting on a table, and fled the area. The purse was empty at the time. The victim sustained injuries to the head and was treated at an area hospital. Investigation continues.

- **Shooting into an Occupied Dwelling** - On April 23<sup>rd</sup> at 2:40AM, police responded to the 2100 block of Silversmith Ct in Woodbridge (22191) for a shooting into an occupied dwelling call. The homeowner reported to police that he was upstairs in the residence when he heard, what was believed to be, gunshots. Upon inspecting the residence, the homeowner discovered a kitchen window which was shattered. No injuries were reported. Later that morning at 8:30AM, police were dispatched to the same 2100 block to another residence for a shooting into an occupied dwelling call. Homeowner reported to police that between 2:00AM and 2:30AM, what was believed to be gunshots were heard in the area. No damage was notched at the time. At daylight, the homeowner discovered a hole in a front window and others in the side of the residence. No injuries were reported.
- **Shooting into an Occupied Dwelling** - On April 24<sup>th</sup> at 12:29PM, police responded to the 5600 block of Roundtree Dr in Dale City (22193) for a shooting into an occupied dwelling call. Homeowner reported to police that between 12:30AM and 2:00AM, a gunshot was heard in the area. No injuries were reported. At daylight, several holes were discovered in the side of the residence. No projectiles actually penetrated the residence. Property damage was minor.

**Incidents:**

**Burglary** - On April 25<sup>th</sup> at 6:10PM, police responded to the 12700 block of Hunterbrook Dr in Woodbridge (22192) for a burglary. Homeowner reported to police that the burglary occurred between 7:00PM and 8:30PM. There were no signs of forced entry into the residence. A laptop valued around \$1,800 was reported missing.

- **Officer Involved Shooting** - On April 25<sup>th</sup> at 7:07PM, Prince William County Police responded to assist in an officer involved shooting incident on Dumfries Rd near the I-95 interchange. ATF Federal Agents were involved in the shooting and will be the agency to contact for further details. Eastbound Dumfries Rd from Van Buren Rd to the interchange will be closed for an undetermined amount of time. Traffic westbound Dumfries will be restricted from three lanes to two lanes. The third lane will be used as a detoured eastbound lane during the investigation. Prince William County Police have charged the suspect in last night's incident on Dumfries Rd near I-95. The suspect is still currently hospitalized for his injuries sustained during the shooting, however, he is expected to make a full recovery. Investigation continues.

- **Assault and Battery on Law Enforcement Officer** - On April 23<sup>rd</sup> at 7:06PM, police responded to the area of the Prince William Pkwy and Telegraph Rd in Woodbridge (22192) for a crash. - **Narcotics Investigation – Search Warrant** - On April 26<sup>th</sup>, members of the Narcotics Task Force concluded a narcotics investigation into the selling of marijuana with the execution of a search warrant at 9701 Clark PI #101 in Manassas (20110). As a result of the search warrant, approximately a ½lb of marijuana and a ½oz of cocaine were seized. The accused is currently being sought in this investigation. Warrants are on file.
