Incidents:

- **Strong Armed Robbery** - On April 3rd at 12:34PM, police responded to the Quantico Tactical Supply Store located within Potomac Mills Mall at 2700 Potomac Mills Cir in Woodbridge (22192) for a robbery. On April 5th at 4:25AM, police were checking Lindsay Chevrolet, a recent victim of tire and rim theft from March, located at 15605 Jefferson Davis Hwy in Woodbridge (22191), and discovered about five 2011 Chevrolet Tahoe's on bricks with tires and rims removed. In total, twelve sets of tires and rims were missing and damage to the vehicles from the bricks totaled around \$28,000. A 2006 Chrysler Town and Country van was found in the lot which contained five sets of tires and rims in addition to tools which would be needed to remove tires from targeted vehicles. Three other sets of tires and rims were found at the scene. This van was a rental which was rented to the accused. Other evidence was recovered which linked the accused to the van. On April 6th, warrants, including a search warrant, were obtained against the accused and his residence of 423 East Luray Ave in Alexandria City.
