February 25, 2011

Incidents:

- **Malicious Wounding** - On February 20th at 9:38AM, police responded to investigate an alleged assault when was reported to have occurred in the 12900 block of Queen Chapel Rd in Woodbridge (22193). The victim, a 19 year old woman of Alexandria, reported to police that she was at a residence in the above area when she was assaulted by an known acquaintance and an another unknown man. During the encounter the victim was punched in the face and kicked. The victim left the residence and contacted police. The victim received medical attention for non-life threatening injuries.

- **Strong-Arm Robbery** - On February 19th at 5:19PM, police responded to the 7-11 located 7800 Centreville Rd in Manassas (20111) for a robbery. Employees reported to police that an unknown man entered the store and asked for cigarettes. While the clerk was still scanning the merchandise, the man grabbed the boxes and ran from the store. No injuries were reported.

Callers reported to police that several gun shots were heard in the area. Two homes were located with damage to the exterior. No injuries were reported.

- **Vandalism / Grand Larceny – PWC School Buses** - On February 18th at 5:59AM, police responded to Garfield High School located at 14000 Smoketown Rd in Woodbridge (22193) for several vandalisms to school buses. The investigation revealed that a total of six buses had been damaged. Several exterior lights on the buses had been broken or stolen while others were broken into and radio equipment missing. Total damage and property stolen was estimated around \$7,000.
- **Brandishing of a Firearm** - On February 18th at 2:20AM, police responded to the 12700 block of Crossman Creek Way in Bristow (20136) for a firearm brandishing call. The victim, a 39 year old man of Bristow, reported to police that he was traveling on Delvin Rd when he encountered the driver of another vehicle. This encounter led to an apparent road rage incident. The victim stated the other driver followed him to the area above then brandished a handgun. No description could be given.
- **Burglary** - On February 20th at 10:52AM, police responded to the 3600 block of Morgan Ct in Dumfries (22025) for a burglary. Homeowner reported to police that the burglary occurred between 12:00PM on February 12th and 10:30AM on February 20th. Entry appeared to have been made through a basement window. - **Burglary / Malicious Wounding** - On February 20th at 7:24AM, police responded to the 5600 block of Roundtree Dr in Woodbridge (22193) for a domestic. The victims, a 22 year old man of Alexandria and a 35 year old woman of Woodbridge, reported to police that the accused, a known acquaintance, had come to the residence in the above area to have a confrontation with the female victim over a previous altercation. The accused forced his way into the residence through the rear door where he then picked up a kitchen knife. The accused began to assault both victims. The female victim sustained a small cut to her arm. The accused then left the residence. The victims were both treated for their injuries which were non-life threatening. The accused was located and arrested without incident.

- **Armed Robbery – Domestic Related** - On February 18th at 10:22PM, police responded to the 8000 block of Juliet Ln in Manassas (20109) for a domestic. The victim, a 22 year old woman of Manassas, reported to police that she was involved in a verbal altercation with the accused, a known acquaintance, which escalated. During the encounter the accused pointed a handgun at the victim and then dragged her out of her vehicle before punching her in the face numerous times. The accused also took the victims purse during the incident. The victim was transported to an area hospital for non-life threatening injuries. The accused was arrested and charged without further incident.

A description was only available for the man who approached the counter.

Arrests:

The investigation revealed that the victim, a 34 year old woman, had been allegedly held against her will at gunpoint by the accused, her husband. The victim was able to get away from the residence and contact police. The accused fled the residence prior to police arrival and is believed to be operating a vehicle. Warrants were obtained. At around 2:00PM, a coordinated effort between Prince William County Police, Spotsylvania County Sheriff Deputies and U.S. Marshals Task Force led to the capture of the accused who was taken into custody in Spotsylvania County. The accused will be turned over to Prince William County Police for processing.

- **Felony Hit and Run** - On February 20th at 4:39PM, police responded to the area of Minnieville Rd and Hereford Rd in Dale City (22193) for a crash. The investigation revealed that the driver, the accused, of a 1998 Chevrolet Blazer was traveling northbound on Minnieville Rd when the vehicle crossed the over into the southbound lanes and struck the driver of a 2005 Ford Taurus which was southbound on Minnieville Rd approaching the left turn lane for Hereford Rd. The investigation revealed that two male juveniles, a 12 year old and a 15 year old, had spray painted a vehicle belonging to a school staff member while it was parked at the school. The two juveniles also spray painted part of the school building itself. It total, the damage was estimated around \$6,000. The juveniles were apprehended by police and charges are pending. The juveniles were released to the custody of their parents/guardians.
