Incidents:

- **Burglary with Intent to Defile** - On January 30th at 5:39AM, police responded to the 1400 block of G St in Woodbridge (22191) for a burglary in progress. The victim, a 36 year old woman of Woodbridge, reported to police that she had heard a noise coming from her living room and went to investigate. The victim discovered her front door was partially opened and that an unknown man was opening a window located near the front door. The unknown man was able to partially enter through the window and grab the victim. The woman struck the man with a lamp post several times which caused him to flee the area. No injuries were reported by the victim.

Lookout:

Black male, between 30 and 40 years of age, 5'09"-5'11" / 160lbs, medium build, short black hair / brown eyes, small neatly groomed mustache
Last seen wearing a black straight brim baseball style cap with a black emblem on front and a black long sleeve hooded sweatshirt

- **Burglary** - On January 25th at 11:03AM, police responded to the 14300 block of Birchdale Ave in Woodbridge (22193) for a burglary. Homeowner reported to police that the burglary occurred between 1:00AM and 10:00AM. There were no signs of forced entry into the residence. Electronics and other items valuing around \$700 were reported missing.

Arrests:

Serious Crash - On January 30th at 7:46PM, police responded to the area of Sudley Rd and I-66 in Manassas (20109) for a crash. The investigation revealed that the driver of a 1988 Dodge Dakota was traveling eastbound on I-66 when he lost control and struck the side of the overpass which caused the vehicle to go airborne over the overpass and land on Sudley Rd below. The vehicle then proceeded to roll over several times before coming to rest on Sudley Rd. The driver was flown to an area hospital for non-life threatening injuries. No other vehicles were involved. The driver, the accused, was the only occupant and was found to be under the influence of alcohol.

Burglary - On February 01st at 7:56AM, police responded to the 4100 block of Gardensen Dr in Woodbridge (22193) for a burglary in progress. Homeowner reported to police that he had heard a strange noise coming from another part of the residence. Upon investigating the noise, the homeowner saw two unknown men exiting the residence through the front door. A check of the residence showed that a rear bedroom window had been smashed out. Entry does not appear to have been made through the window and there were no other signs of forced entry. No items were reported missing. Both of the men fled prior to police arrival.

Arrests:

Possession of a Schedule I or II Narcotic - On February 01st at 6:00PM, police were patrolling the area of Merchants Plz Shopping Center located at 14130 Dale Blvd in Dale City (22193). Police made contact with the two accused individuals who were sitting inside a vehicle in the parking lot. A consensual search of the vehicle resulted in prescription medication, oxycodone and fentanyl patches, which were found to be in possession of the driver, COHAN.
