***Incidents reported for the week ending:***

**January 28, 2011**

### **Incidents:**

- **Attempted Armed Robbery** - On January 22<sup>nd</sup> at 7:18PM, police responded to EZ Checks Cashed located at 13251 Occoquan Rd in Woodbridge (22191) for an attempted robbery. It was reported to police that three unknown men entered the store where one of the men was armed with a handgun while another had pepper spray. The man with the pepper spray walked up to the counter and sprayed into the money slot. No entry was gained beyond the front entrance. The men fled the area in a vehicle after being told the police were coming. No injuries reported.

#### ***Lookout:***

3 Hispanic males, between 17 and 30 years of age, between 5'2" and 5'5", medium build

1<sup>st</sup> male was last seen wearing a camel button-up jacket over a black hooded sweatshirt, green cargos and light colored shoes

3<sup>rd</sup> male was last seen wearing a navy blue zip up hooded sweatshirt with the number '12' on it and a design on the back, light jeans and tan boots

- **Attempted Burglary** - On January 22<sup>nd</sup> at 11:35PM, police responded to the 2900 block of Akron St in Dale City (22193) for an attempted burglary. Homeowner reported to police that he heard someone knocking on his residence and at the same time an unknown man was seen opening the screen door on a rear sliding glass door. Then men, once realizing someone was home, fled the area in pickup truck. No entry was made into the residence and no items were reported missing. No descriptions could be given.
- **Attempted Burglary** - On January 21<sup>st</sup> at 5:00PM, police responded to the Bull Run Mountain Civil Association located at 1811 Ridge Rd in Haymarket (20169) for an attempted burglary. - **Reckless Handling of a Firearm** - On January 23<sup>rd</sup> at 9:47PM, police responded to the 2700 block of Brier Pond Cir in Woodbridge (22191) for a call of shots fired. Caller reported to police that a vehicle was seen parked in a parking space and that the driver was firing a handgun out of the window. The investigation revealed that a vehicle, driven by the accused, had struck and damaged a school zone speed limit sign. The sign was then dragged underneath the vehicle when it finally dislodged and came to rest in front of Fannie Fitzgerald Elementary School. A witness to the incident was able to provide police with information that led to the vehicles whereabouts and driver identity. The vehicle was located in the 15700 block of Brightwood Ln unoccupied and disabled. The accused was later located at 14257 Princedale Ave where he was arrested and charged in the incident. Police later discovered that the accused had been intoxicated at the time of the crash.

On January 24<sup>th</sup>, police conducted an investigation into the distribution and possession of heroin in the area of Sudley Rd and Balls Ford Rd in Manassas (20109). As a result, the accused, HARRIS, was detained for distributing narcotics. The accused individuals, TESTERMAN and HENSLEY, were arrested and charged for the purchase/possession of heroin. A search was conducted at HARRIS' room at the Quality Inn #111 located at 10653 Balls Ford Rd in Manassas and his vehicle.
