- **Suspicious Death Investigation** - On March 23rd at 9:50AM, Prince William County Department of Fire and Rescue responded to the 1200 block of Bayside Ave, the Bayvue Apartments, in Woodbridge (22191) for an outside fire in a dumpster. Upon extinguishing the fire, fire personnel located what was believed to be a body inside of the dumpster. Police were immediately dispatched to the scene at 10:05AM. The Medical Examiner responded, as well, and has confirmed that what was found was human remains. The body will be transferred to the Medical Examiner's Office for further analysis. Police are still working on an identification of the body. No age or gender is known at this time. The Fire Marshal's Office is assisting in the fire aspect of this incident. More information will be released as it becomes available.

- **Attempted Malicious Wounding of a Law Enforcement Officer** - On March 22nd, police conducted a narcotics investigation into the selling of cocaine in the area of Balls Ford Rd in Manassas (20109). A vehicle stop was conducted a possible suspect vehicle at Sudley Rd and Grant Ave. Police, while standing next to the vehicle, attempted to detain the driver, the accused, under suspicions of marijuana possession. The accused ignored officers commands and speed away at a high rate of speed striking one officer and nearly hitting another. A pursuit ensued which ended a short distance later. A search of the vehicle resulted in a scale, packaging material, cocaine, and U.S. Currency.
