Incidents:

Aggravated Malicious Wounding - On February 26th at 11:30PM, police responded to the 8400 block of Aubrey Dr in Manassas (20111) for an assault. The investigation revealed that the victim, a 46 year old man of Manassas, had been assaulted by an unknown person who entered the victim's residence and struck him over the head with a blunt object. The assailant fled prior to police arrival. The victim received medical attention for his injuries which are non-life threatening. The incident appears to be a targeted act towards the victim. Investigation continues.

Vicious Animal - On February 27th at 11:10AM, police responded to the area of Conway Dr and Idlebrook Ct in Independent Hill (22193) for a vicious dog call. Caller reported to police that a brown dog had attempted to bite him while he was outside of his residence. Police and Animal Control arrived and located the dog in the 14700 block of Conway Dr. As the officers were attempting to capture the dog, it became very aggressive and lunged toward the Animal Control Officer biting her on her hand and knocking her to the ground. The dog then continued its aggression towards police. Officers shot at the dog which ran from the area. It is unknown if the dog was struck. Police attempted to locate the dog but were unsuccessful. The Animal Control Officer did not require medical attention.

Reckless Handling of a Firearm - On February 26th at 2:32AM, police responded to the 13200 block of Queensdale Dr in Woodbridge (22193) for a call of shots fired. Several callers reported to police that they had heard, what was believed to be, several gun shots in the area above. No shooters were seen by any of the callers. Police checked the area. No injuries or damage to property were reported.

Vandalism – Lake Ridge Middle School - On February 25th at 2:52PM, police responded to Lake Ridge Middle School located at 12350 Mohican Rd in Lake Ridge (22192) for a vandalism. The investigation revealed that an unknown person(s) had entered the 8th graders bathroom and vandalized several items including bathroom stalls, mirrors and walls. Damage was estimated around \$75.
