Incidents:

- **Assault by Mob / Malicious Wounding** - On April 30th at 11:45PM, police responded to investigate an alleged assault which was reported to have occurred in the area of Reservoir Lp and Hourglass Dr in Dumfries (22191). The victims, two 16 year old males both of Woodbridge, reported to police that they were walking in the area above when they were approached by a large number of unknown men, possible teenagers. The group assaulted the two victims before fleeing the area. The victims received medical attention for their injuries. No description could be given for any of the assailants.
- **Assault by Mob / Firearms Violation** - On April 30th at 1:56AM, police responded to Water Edge located at 13188 Marina Way in Woodbridge (22191) for an assault. The investigation revealed that the victim, a 24 year old man of Alexandria, had been assaulted by a group of unknown men. The group fled prior to police arrival and the victim was treated at an area hospital for non-life threatening injuries. While investigating this incident, police were notified of shots fired in the parking lot around 3:34AM. No shooter was located. Also, no injuries or property damage were reported. It does not appear the two incidences are related. The investigation continues into the assault.

The victim, a 27 year old woman of Woodbridge, reported to police that the accused, a known acquaintance, forced entry into her residence by breaking a window to unlock a door. Once inside the residence, the accused allegedly assault the victim and stole her phone before fleeing the area on foot. The victim sustained minor injuries.

Arrests:

Crash – Fatality - On May 3rd at 6:08AM, police responded to the 13200 block of Aden Rd in Nokesville (20181) for a crash. The investigation revealed that the driver of 2005 Pontiac GT was traveling westbound on Aden Rd in the eastbound lane. As the driver was traveling in the area above, the vehicle crested a hill in the wrong lane and struck the driver of a 1993 GEO Tracker head on. The driver of the Pontiac GT was ground transported to an area hospital with head injuries. The driver of the GEO Tracker was flown to an area trauma center where he succumbed to his injuries. The investigation further revealed that both drivers were not wearing a seatbelt and that both drivers were the only occupants of their respective vehicle. Speed was factor in this collision and the driver of the Pontiac GT has been charged. Investigation continues.
